TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

**Henhurst Hill, Hopley Road, Burton Road and Postern Road
Burton upon Trent and Rough Hay**

NOTICE is hereby given that Staffordshire County Council on 20/08/2026 intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Henhurst Hill in Burton upon Trent, Hopley Road, Burton Road and Postern Road in Rough Hay, at the junction where the four roads meet, unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to properties on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

The order will come into operation on 1st September 2026 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 23rd October 2026.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the footway resurfacing, tactile crossing and installation of signs and posts works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
