**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
Albert Street
Burton Upon Trent**

NOTICE is hereby given that Staffordshire County Council on 17/09/2026 intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Albert Street in Burton Upon Trent to the rear of Dixy Chicken, unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to properties on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

The order will come into operation on 25th September 2026 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 25th September 2026.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the pole replacement works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
